- Enrolled in a two or four year accredited college
- Community service
- Successful interview

Susan Cannon Jones Celebration Scholarship supports the higher education goals of a deserving, non-traditional female student who is also a single parent. The recipient will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Between 17 and 35 years of age
- GPA 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Demonstrated financial need
- Enrolled in a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university
